It accommodates 4" or 4-11/16" square boxes and plaster rings, even multi-gang boxes. The rigid design eliminates the need for far-side supports. It can be used on wood or metal studs. Center cutouts help in leveling for quick installation.

Made of galvanized steel, the RACO Adjustable Open Center Bracket is perfect for commercial construction. It provides maximum flexibility for installers while reducing SKU's on the jobsite. The 9020R is UL Listed.
