To maintain superior sealing, closed cell oil-resistant neoprene gaskets and captivated cover screws that thread into sealed wells are provided. External mounting plates are included on the top and bottom. Grounding provisions are included.

The Wiegmann stainless steel operator interface line includes 6 different size pushbutton enclosures, ranging from 1-6 holes. They provide NEMA 4X level protection. Perfect for protecting switch wiring from dust, dirt, oil and water in harsh, even corrosive, industrial environments.
