

Versatile Bench

Conveyor support & shelf setup

A new aluminum rail system can have broad applications. Consider your customer's needs and the versatility, then let your imagination run wild. This design features three shelves and a conveyor supported by the bench cross member. All frame components are standard except the length of some of the rails which may need cutting to fit the shelf width. You can use standard track nuts to fasten conveyor to rail.



Neat & Tidy 36" Bench Back

Aluminum frame provides strength & rigidity


Many workstation applications don't require overhead tool rails. A vertical structure to hold tools and parts can do the job. Create a strong, rigid small workbench back using **WA50** track, standard brackets, and accessories. All components are right out of the catalog. Just add a peg board or magnet/marker board, or even a hose reel as a finishing touch.



Bench Top Bridge

Assemble with ease


Use a tool balancer to an overhead rail to bridge workstations. Move assemblies along for an easy workflow. You just need a rolling hanger or trolley to change it up.

Jibs with balancers could be your answer!


Foam guns, staplers, and glue guns are just as important as impact wrenches. Keep them out of the way yet in reach. There are many possible ways to make the "end of the line" people more productive with tool jibs.



Quick Jibs

WS50-MB Mounting Base doubles as Boom Mount


Hang **WS50** steel track or **WA50** extruded aluminum track on standard 3" OD vertical columns to make jibs or rail supports. It's easy and inexpensive. Height is fully adjustable. More than one "boom" can be mounted to each column, as shown in the inset, or two booms can support longer track. May also be hung overhead using **WS00-CC** ceiling mounting columns. Maximum boom length with one end supported is 3 feet. 50 lbs maximum capacity.



150 lb Jib for big tools

Keeps large air or electric tools suspended overhead

An extra-heavy-duty jib is ideal for Ergo 3 balancers with heavy torque wrenches and similar equipment. Boom swings full 360° but you can limit it with optional stops. Create a six-to-10-foot boom with rugged **WS60** rail with ladder reinforcing. Ten-foot-high vertical column is 4" o.d. schedule 40 pipe. Boom supported by tapered bearing and heavy-duty rollers. Includes wire rope festoon system with two trolleys.



150 lb Jib provides overhead access

Swings out of the way when not in use


The 150-pound capacity of our extra-heavy-duty jib is ideal for supporting large hoses or cables. Boom swings out to perform task, stores flush with wall when not in use. Mount the hose or cable easily using cable clamps and suitable protective sleeves. If not installed next to wall, swing limiting stops must be used.



300 lb Capacity Swing Jib

Rugged I-beam boom swings full 360°


If you use large tools with air balancers, our **W6S** 300 lb. tool jib is for you. The flanged wheel trolley rolls on an I-beam mounted to a tubular steel column. Air supply is conveniently handled by a swivel fitting at the top of the column and festoon trolleys leading to the balancer trolley. Boom swings full 360°, supported by heavy tapered roller bearing and two rollers.



Twin Booms increase productivity

Puts tools where needed, out of way when not needed


Use a twin boom jib to put tools into the hands of people working apart on a large product (like the bow and stern of a boat). Each boom swings approximately 170° but cannot cross. Stops can be set to allow free swing or to lock boom in straight position and at every 15° in either direction. Unit is not available as a kit—order the individual parts (model numbers shown below).

Manage multiple air tools and cables



Gantry Tool Crane

Straddles work area or assembly line


Assemble this highly versatile gantry tool crane from standard components and kits. Capacity varies depending on which components are used. A 50 lb. capacity crane uses **WS-50** components and a **WS50-ET05** or **WS50-ET06** tool crane kit. The rugged 250 lb. capacity unit is assembled from WS-60 components and a **WS60-ET06** tool crane kit. To maintain full 250 lb. capacity, the rails runs must be no more than 72" in length. Longer spans decrease capacity. The cranes are designed to provide overhead tool support and are NOT designed for lifting. **WS50** components have bake polyester finish. **WS60** components are galvanized or zinc plated.



Put Balancer over work area

WS60 Tool Crane reaches out to task


Originally designed to facilitate removal of cast aluminum car wheels from casting machines, the structure below was constructed from standard components (the **WS60-ET09** tool crane is not cataloged but is available). It's ideal for heavier tools on assembly lines and similar applications. Total rail length can be customized to fit the job. The one shown here is 36' long. Maximum capacity, including balancer plus tool or air hoist plus load is 85 lbs. Using more than one tool crane is not recommended unless some provision is made to prevent the cranes from coming too close together. This could overload the rail structure. Secure and properly anchor the columns (suggested anchoring details are provided with each column).



Heavy-duty Overhead Crane


Support up to 250 lbs

Allow overhead handling of extra-capacity tools with maximum safety and minimum cost using this rugged bridge crane. Mount components to rugged **WS60** rails. Available in six- or 12-foot kits.




Tool Crane mounts in two **WS60** rails. Rails must be parallel and level to allow free travel and must be supported every 6' (1.9m). Recommended distance between support rails is the length of tool rail less 12" (305mm). Tool rail and reinforcing rail may be cut if shorter length required. Do not span more than 72" (1829mm) without reinforcing rail installed. MAXIMUM RATED CAPACITY OF TOOL CRANE is 250 lbs (112.5 kg) including tool, balancer, and attachments. Unit depth is 37.875" (962mm) bumper–to–bumper.



High safety, low cost

This rugged bridge crane allows overhead tool handling with maximum safety and minimum cost. Mount components to standard **WS-50** or **WA-50** rails. Available as complete kits to speed assembly.



Tool Crane mounts in two **WS50** rails. Rails must be parallel and level to allow free travel of crane. Recommended distance between support rails is length of tool rail less 12" (305mm). MAXIMUM RATED CAPACITY OF TOOL CRANE is 50 lbs (22.5 kg) including tool, balancer, and attachments. Unit depth is 24.25" (616mm) bumper—to—bumper.

Overhead Tool Crane includes (4) WS50–06TP plain trolleys, (2) WS50–ETK tool track bridges, (2) WS50–HG hanger brackets, (2) WS50–EP end caps, (2) WS50–Es end stops, (1) WS50–BTL Labyrinth tool trolley, (1) WS50 tool rail (length per model) and all assembly hardware.



Heavy-Duty Continuous Tool Rails


Provide 4-way adjustment

al tool rails run the entire length of 60' conveyor spanned by multiple 24" long rolling rails with balancer trolleys. Easily reach all areas of conveyor surface. Extruded Aluminum vertical supports fit perfectly into sleeves on the 30" or 36" bottom plates or **WS50-MB** mounting bases. Also recommended, for added stability, is the **WS50-SCB** Leg Box. You can also use a single 60' rail with numerous balancer trolleys.



Use Aluminum Track for Heavy-Duty Continuous Tool Rail


While Extruded Aluminum Track will not fit into the "coupler" on the top of **WS50-UFxx** Bench Leg Bases, it fits perfectly into the sleeve on the bottom plate (as it does on all other mounting bases). Bottom plates, both 30" and 36", are available separately. Order model **WS50-UF30B** (30") or **WS50-UF36B** (36"). Also available separately is the **WS50-SCB** Leg Box.



Build a Twin-Rail Assembly Line Workstation

Any length, aluminum rail makes it versatile


This setup allows an infinite number of variations. Be sure to stay within the following size and capacity parameters: Maximum 10' wide and 8' (6' is ideal) between uprights, 50 lbs. maximum per trolley and no more than one trolley per upright. Design the structure to be as long as needed. Aluminum rail is available in 20' lengths, but make sure splice angles don't interfere with hanger disks.



Heavy-Duty Tool Rail Hanger

250 lb capacity handles even the heaviest tools

Thru bolts both top and bottom (see photo) act as a safety net. Thru bolts are included with the mounting bases. These components are not sold as a kit because the galvanized C-60 Track, both vertical and horizontal, can vary greatly in length. Track must be supported every six feet to preserve 250 lb. capacity rating.



Now you can quickly and accurately hang and align **W\$50** tool rails beneath or beside beams. **W\$50-BCH** Beam Clamp Hanger Bracket or separate **W\$-BC** Beam Clamp (with track nut) require no drilling or welding. Hanger Brackets attach to beam flanges from 2.625" to 5.25" wide. Beam Clamps affix **W\$50** support arms to top flange (Figure 3) or **W\$450** aluminum track to bottom flange perpendicular to or at an angle to beam (Figure 2). All components are zinc plated.




Don't just lay tools on five gallon pails. Use an aluminum tool rail (or steel with traditional hanger brackets) hung from **W\$50** supports. Fasten support structures to back of board by **W\$50-MP** Universal Bases bolted to existing stand uprights.

Add reach & flexibility


Easily move a 30 lb. tool to any spot on a 40 ft. assembly line, including in or out 8+ ft. Use two aluminum rails hung beneath fixed jibs mounted on 11 ft. columns. Insert **WS50-10HR** rolling hangers with side guide rollers into the rails. Then, hang two 9 ft. aluminum rails from the trolleys and a third **WS50-10HR** trolley with **CVS-11** swivel clevis in one of the rails.

- 1 Slide trolley into rail. NOTE: WS30-xx TORQ-ARMS go into WS30 rails. WS50-xx TORQ-ARMS go into WS50 rails.
- 2 Install end stop and end cap into rail. Securely tighten bolts clamping end stop to rail. WARNING: Improperly tightened end stop bolts could result in damage to equipment or personal injury.
- 3 Install tool onto TORQ-ARM and connect air line.
- 4 Adjust tool balancer for desired action.









Here's your answer to production or maintenance wiring jobs. Roll the wire to the job, unspool what you need, and return the cart to a convenient storage place. Made of strong but light **WA50** aluminum rail with formed steel brackets, the cart measures 54" high, 36" deep and 33.6" wide. There is a 27" clear space between spool shaft brackets, which are fully adjustable. The cart is available with four heavy-duty casters (two fixed and two swivel with locks), two fixed casters and two glides or, for semi-permanent installation, with four glides. Swivel casters may be installed at either front or back. All components, except hardware, finished with chip-resistant baked polyester coating. Some assembly required. **Maximum capacity: 300 lbs.**


Maintain flexibility on the plant floor without sacrificing safety and productivity. Our **Push 'n Place™** portable workstation moves to where the action is. It rolls easily on four heavy-duty locking, swivel casters. Constructed of light but strong extruded aluminum rail, it measures 36" deep and 90" high, including casters. Frame is 44" wide o.c., perfect for under a 5' conveyor section, while the tool bar is 60" long and can be fitted with splice angles to adjoin two or more units. Bin Bar, air manifold and balancer trolley with fitting plus 3/8" hose are standard. Frame is finished with beige baked polyester. Brackets are matte black.






Do you ever need five or six foot wide* shelves on a mobile unit? Or 18" deep shelves? Maybe two shelves and a bin bar, or six bin bars, three on each side? Add a power bar for electrical power or a manifold for air? Now you can construct a mobile shelf cart to your exact requirements. Pick either the complete kit (HWP-SCxx) which includes three 12" x 30", 42", 54", or 66" shelves, aluminum frame, cover strip for the slots, four swivel casters, and all hardware. Or choose the size frame that will fit your needs and equip it with either 12" or 18" deep shelves and any of numerous workstation accessories. The basic frames, available in 3', 4', 5' and 6' widths*, are constructed of sturdy aluminum with heavy steel brackets. All assembly hardware is included. Order shelves to fit cart width, either 12" or 18" deep. Other standard accessories such as bin bars, power bars, and manifolds are easily added to the frame. Cover strip is not included with frame kits but may be ordered separately. Bin boxes are not included. Below is a list of most components, including prices.






Adjustable Foot Rest

Easy on the legs


Seated or standing, your workers can be more productive and more comfortable using a foot rest. In addition, use of a foot rest offers a degree of protection from back or leg strain. Fully adjustable and strong enough for heavy industrial applications, it's constructed of steel with extruded aluminum foot bar. Standard model measures 29" wide, 12.75" deep and 12.25" high. Smaller "under desk" version measures is 23" wide. Both rest on four non-skid rubber feet. The foot bar is easily adjustable from 4" to 11" above the floor and tilts 15° fore and aft. Frame is finished with matte black baked polyester coating. Foot bar is natural aluminum with two anti-skid strips.






Our 1/4" ID coiled hose is designed to run from the trolley fitting to the tool. It stays up, out of the way yet is so flexible you will hardly know it's there. For connecting fitting on tool trolley to air supply or manifold, select the strong, flexible, 3/8" ID air lines. Available in eleven lengths and feature swivel fittings at both ends for minimal trolley interference.






Shelf fits any upright spacing

Shelf attaches to uprights with track nuts (like old style) and has adjustable tilt (also like old style). Positive four position tilt with holes rather than slots. Brackets attach to shelf with track nuts into lateral rail welded to underside of shelf. Four models are available, fitting workstations with upright column center-to-center spacing to 68" (1727mm). Baked polyester finish is beige on shelf and matt black on brackets. Shelf includes black end caps.











SHOCK STOP to the Rescue

Prevents cable damage on "over-powered" balancers

Cable breakage on tool balancers is rare because they use tough and durable nylon coated steel aircraft cable. Most failures involve a break at the eye—the point just above the clip that is swaged around the cable.

The primary cause of cable failure on Ergo 2 balancers is user error. Over tensioning the spring and allowing the tool to slam back into the balancer from a fully extended position. Both conditions are often present.

Repeated over-tensioned slamming slowly pushes the cable stop down the cable until it is against the eye and can go no farther. Then it hits the reel housing every time the tool is returned to the raised position. This causes the cable to bend at the point between the stop and the eye. Eventually it fatigues and breaks.

The obvious way to prevent this type of cable damage is better customer education. However, may not be easy with a product as simple to use as a tool balancer. The customer buys it, hangs it, and a variety of people use and adjust it.

The Shock Stop provides a mechanical way to minimize cable damage. It consists of a new fixed stop, a compression spring, and a second cable stop designed to slide. The kit installs easily = by removing the existing stop, threading the eye through the spring, and installing the two new stops with the slider on top.

Shock Stop can be used on any Ergo 2 balancer. It is not needed on smaller Ergo 1 balancers.
