



Type I Optic Pattern



Type I distribution:

- Used near center walkways and other pathways
- Concentration of light projects to the side in two opposite directions

Type III Optic pattern



Type III distribution:

- Used near one edge of roadways, lots, and other large areas
- Concentration of light projects to the side in two opposite directions as well as to the front

Type V Optic Pattern



Type V distribution:

- Used in the center of roadways, lots, intersection pathways, and other large areas
- Concentration of light projects evenly to all sides



White Light:

Warm white lighting (3000K) contains more red, yellow, and orange tones which creates a softer more comfortable atmosphere.

Cooler white light (5000K) has more blue tones which creates a more natural, mid-day white light for better workday production.



Green Light:

The nighttime sky is increasingly illuminated by artificial light sources.

Many nocturnally migrating birds die or lose a large amount of their energy reserves during migration as a result of encountering artificial light sources. Migratory birds require lighting from the green/blue color spectrum for clearer compass orientation.



Amber Light:

Research has shown that thousands of sea turtles hatched every year are disoriented by artificial white light.

Long-wavelength lighting such as amber light are less disruptive than white light. Typical site and area lighting causes confusion to hatchlings who rely on moonlight to guide them towards water. Amber LED's help minimize this confusion.

Eco-friendly:

With a much slimmer profile, up to 3 times the amount of VMLX fixtures can fit onto a single pallet compared to previous VM series helping cut down on shipping materials and storage footprint. The new VMLX also offers up to **3 times** reduced packaging compared to previous VM series eliminating the need for more packing material.
