

POLE PLATES

With "One Step Pole Plates," grounding pole equipment is possible without the problems of having to drive a ground rod. Just place the plate in the hole with six inches of Contact GF back fill material below and above the copper plate. Then connect the wire to the pole above the ground line. This easy process is a quick and efficient way to get the job done.

This installation is equivalent to a ground rod driven into undisturbed soil.
