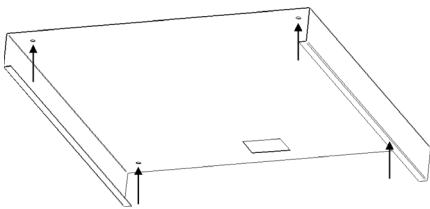

**WARNING:** To avoid shock hazard, disconnect the power at the panel board (circuit breaker box) before beginning installation.

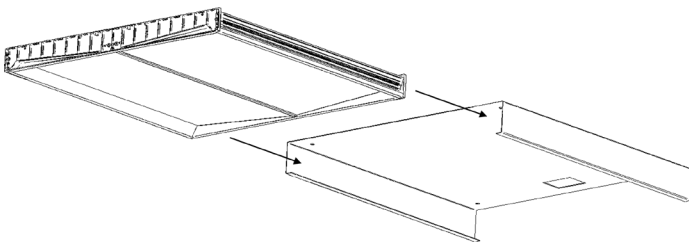
**STEP 1**

Mount the one-piece backplate to the hard ceiling using fasteners supplied by others. Ensure that it is tight to the ceiling.



**STEP 2**

Slide the fixture into the backplate so that the cutout on the surface mount frame aligns with the electrical feed point on the fixture.



**STEP 3**

Make electrical connections.

**STEP 4**

Insert the endcaps into the backplate. The top and sides of each endcap should fit tightly inside the profile of the backplate. The bottom flange on the end caps should be below the bottom flange of the backplate.
