Addendum—SP2 to Page/Party® Bridge

Confidentiality Notice

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General Information

This addendum covers the initial connection to a factory configured Model 370-901 SP2 to Page/Party Bridge. The bridge's factory default IP address is now set as a static IP address with the following configuration:

- IP Address—192.168.100.100
- Subnet Mask—255.255.255.0
- Default Gateway—192.168.100.200

This change prevents connection failures to the bridge when a DHCP server is not present on the network where the device is installed.

Procedure

Software Installation

SP2 to Page/Party® Bridges are configured using the GUDA (GAI-TRONICS Universal Device Application) software:

1. Obtain the software from GAI-Tronics website at www.gai-tronics.com.
2. Hover the mouse over the RESOURCES tab at the top of the webpage.
3. Under SOFTWARE, click on GUDA – GAI-TRONICS UNIVERSAL DEVICE APPLICATION
4. Click the GUDA SOFTWARE – DOWNLOAD [.EXE] button to download the application
5. After the download is complete, install the GUDA software.

PC Configuration

Configure the PC with the GUDA software installed with a static IP address on the same network as the bridge. The address chosen must be on the class C network 192.168.100.x with a subnet mask set to 255.255.255.0. The host ID *x* can be any number between 1 and 254 excluding 100 and 200.

SP2 to Page/Party Bridge Connection

1. Launch the GUDA software.
2. Click the refresh button to the right of the **SELECT NETWORK INTERFACE** field at the bottom of the window.
3. Click the dropdown arrow for the **SELECT NETWORK INTERFACE** field and select the adapter with the statically assigned IP address.
4. Click the **FIND DEVICES** button.
Unconfigured bridge devices appear as shown (see [Figure 2](#))

5. Double click the **SP2-PAGEPARTY BRIDGE-MAC-ADDR** to configure the bridge.
6. Continue with step 5 under the configuration section in Pub. 42004-525A, Model 370-901 SP2 to Page/Party Bridge to complete the bridge's configuration.

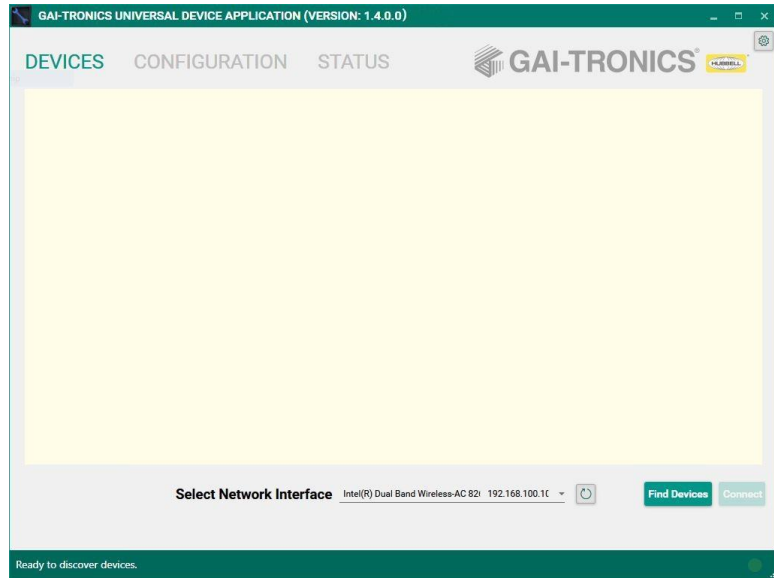


Figure 1. Initial GUDA Screen

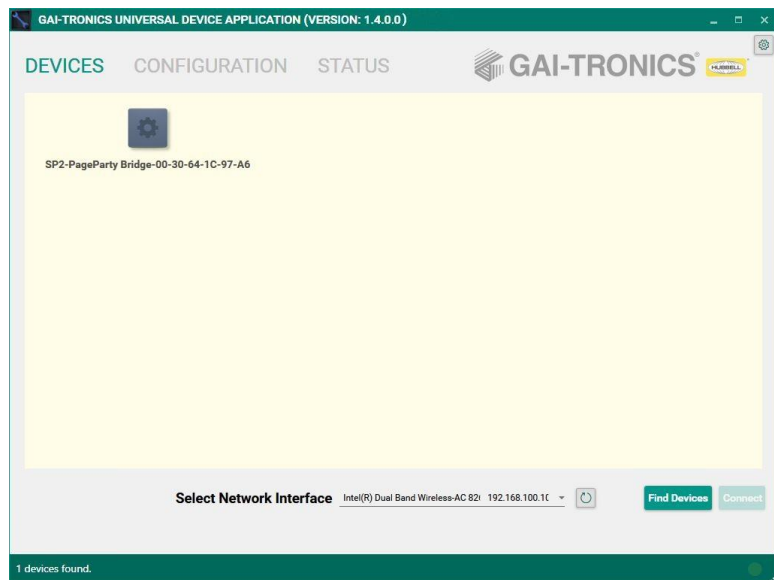


Figure 2. Devices Found

Warranty

Equipment. GAI-Tronics warrants for a period of one (1) year from the date of shipment, that any GAI-Tronics equipment supplied hereunder shall be free of defects in material and workmanship, shall comply with the then-current product specifications and product literature, and if applicable, shall be fit for the purpose specified in the agreed-upon quotation or proposal document. If (a) Seller's goods prove to be defective in workmanship and/or material under normal and proper usage, or unfit for the purpose specified and agreed upon, and (b) Buyer's claim is made within the warranty period set forth above, Buyer may return such goods to GAI-Tronics' nearest depot repair facility, freight prepaid, at which time they will be repaired or replaced, at Seller's option, without charge to Buyer. Repair or replacement shall be Buyer's sole and exclusive remedy. The warranty period on any repaired or replacement equipment shall be the greater of the ninety (90) day repair warranty or one (1) year from the date the original equipment was shipped. In no event shall GAI-Tronics warranty obligations with respect to equipment exceed 100% of the total cost of the equipment supplied hereunder. Buyer may also be entitled to the manufacturer's warranty on any third-party goods supplied by GAI-Tronics hereunder. The applicability of any such third-party warranty will be determined by GAI-Tronics.

Services. Any services GAI-Tronics provides hereunder, whether directly or through subcontractors, shall be performed in accordance with the standard of care with which such services are normally provided in the industry. If the services fail to meet the applicable industry standard, GAI-Tronics will re-perform such services at no cost to buyer to correct said deficiency to Company's satisfaction provided any and all issues are identified prior to the demobilization of the Contractor's personnel from the work site. Re-performance of services shall be Buyer's sole and exclusive remedy, and in no event shall GAI-Tronics warranty obligations with respect to services exceed 100% of the total cost of the services provided hereunder.

Warranty Periods. Every claim by Buyer alleging a defect in the goods and/or services provided hereunder shall be deemed waived unless such claim is made in writing within the applicable warranty periods as set forth above. Provided, however, that if the defect complained of is latent and not discoverable within the above warranty periods, every claim arising on account of such latent defect shall be deemed waived unless it is made in writing within a reasonable time after such latent defect is or should have been discovered by Buyer.

Limitations / Exclusions. The warranties herein shall not apply to, and GAI-Tronics shall not be responsible for, any damage to the goods or failure of the services supplied hereunder, to the extent caused by Buyer's neglect, failure to follow operational and maintenance procedures provided with the equipment, or the use of technicians not specifically authorized by GAI-Tronics to maintain or service the equipment. **THE WARRANTIES AND REMEDIES CONTAINED HEREIN ARE IN LIEU OF AND EXCLUDE ALL OTHER WARRANTIES AND REMEDIES, WHETHER EXPRESS OR IMPLIED BY OPERATION OF LAW OR OTHERWISE, INCLUDING ANY WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE.**

Return Policy

If the equipment requires service, contact your Regional Service Center for a return authorization number (RA#). Equipment should be shipped prepaid to GAI-Tronics with a return authorization number and a purchase order number. If the equipment is under warranty, repairs or a replacement will be made in accordance with the warranty policy set forth above.
