

Turnbuckle

"Turnbuckles are used as adjustable extensionlinks to maintain proper tower clearance onassemblies at tower end. Jaw ends are supplied with bolt, nut, andhumpback cotter pin. Add "LN" suffix if jam nuts are required."



Features

- "Turnbuckle, 3/4", Jaw-Jaw, Forged Steel, Diameter = .75", Take Up = 12.00" and Ult. Strength = 26,000 LBS
- The torque required to rotate the bossof a turnbuckle under tension can be calculated by the formula:
- T = 2 (kdW/12) ft-lb
- Where: k = Friction factor (0.16)
- d = Nominal thread diameter (inches)
- W = Applied tension load (lb)
- Example: 1-1/2" turnbuckle under 4,000 lb tension
- $T = 2(0.16 \times .75 \times 4000 / 12) = 80 \text{ ft-lb}''$
